behind a row of tall bushes.

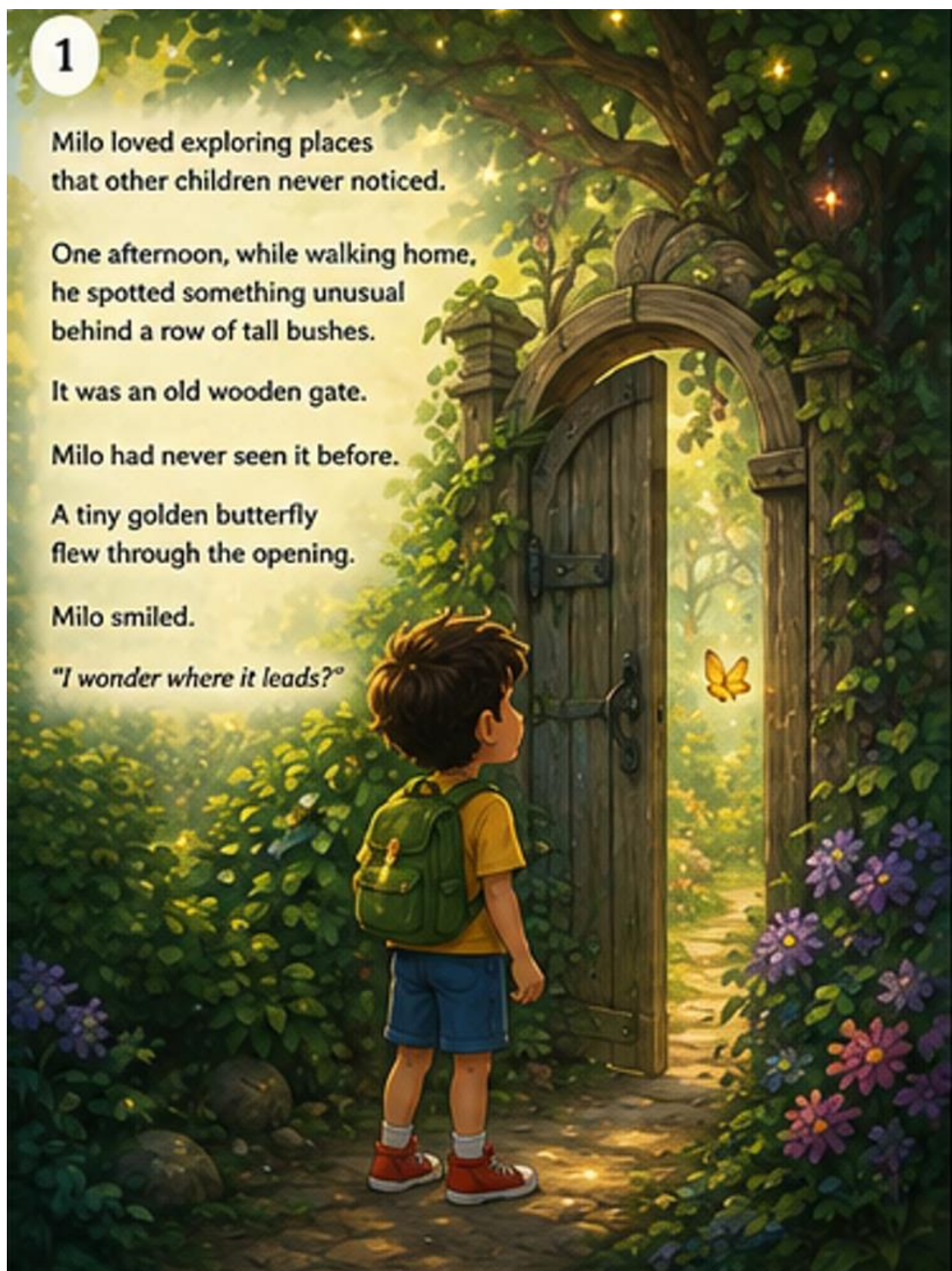
It was an old wooden gate.

some flowers had closed.

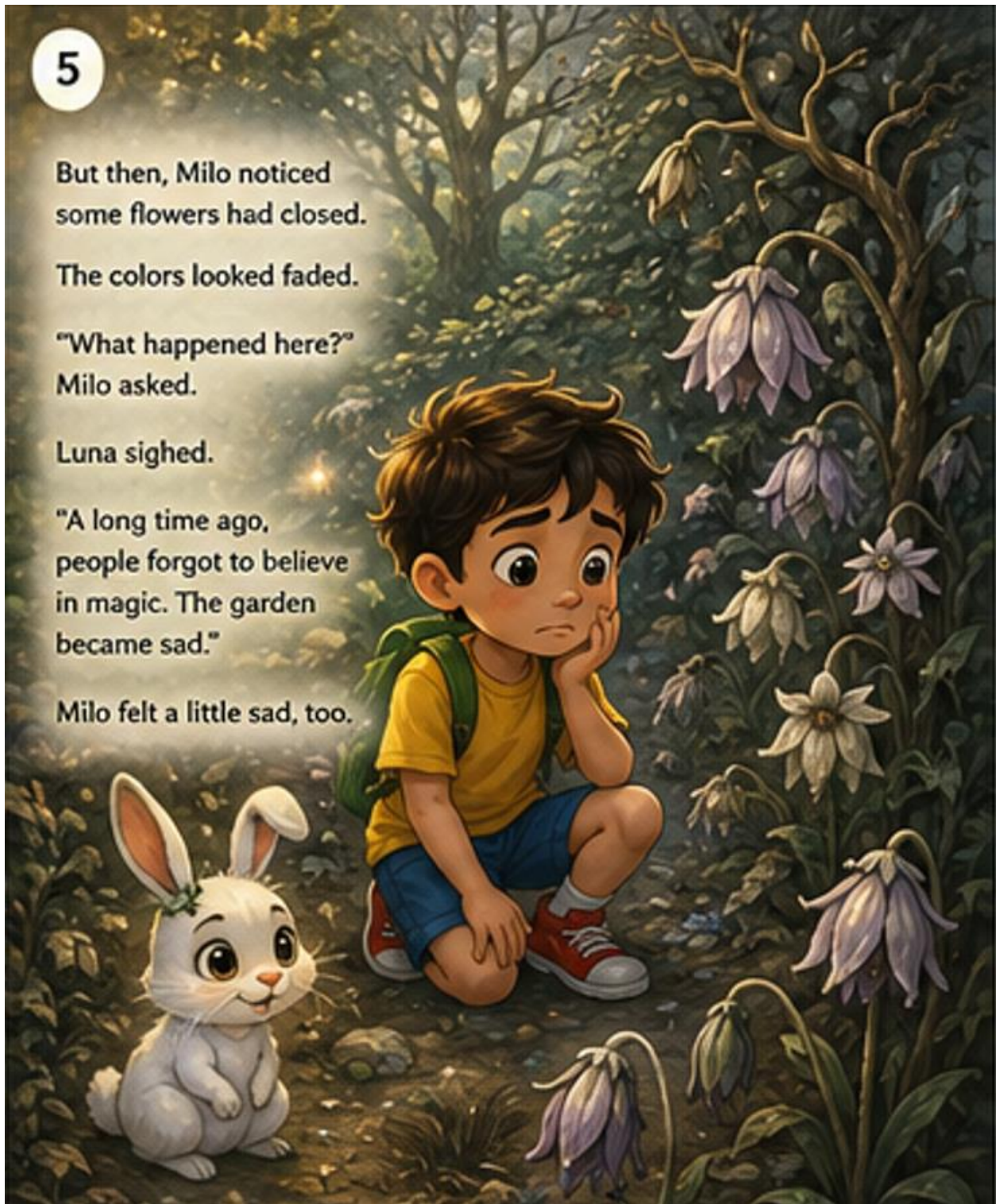
The colors looked faded.
